Petitioner appears to have constructed illegal basement over a 2-1/2 storeyed construction upon plot no.40-B Rajinder Nagar, Jalandhar. Perhaps at the time of grant of occupation certificate, the said basement was filled up with soil to escape detection, since there was no sanction building plan for construction of the said basement. Upon the complaints filed by the residents of the area regarding removal of soil from the basement in the night, the Nagar Nigam, Jalandhar appears to have threatened to initiate action under Section 269(1) of the Nagar Nigam Act of Punjab Municipal Corporation 1976. In response the petitioner is stated to have made a request for compounding of such violation.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present writ petition to pursue his remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
