By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks direction to respondents to grant him the benefit of stepping up to the petitioner to bring him at par with his junior of reserved category on his catching up in the cadre of Commercial Assistant with all consequential benefits.

The learned counsel contends that the representation dated 12.04.2013 (Annexure P-10) moved by the petitioner for the redressal of his grievance for the payment at par with reserved category candidate promoted in the higher cadre on the basis of reserved roster point, is still pending with respondent No.2. He further states that he will be satisfied in case, the same be decided in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 5956 of 2008, titled as **Charan Dass Vs. State of Haryana**,

decided on 18.11.2008.

Keeping in view the statement made by the learned ocunsel for the petitioner, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, to decide the representation, Annexure P-10, in terms of Charan Dass case (Supra), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
