AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner asserts that the works assigned to him were duly executed and completed in the year 2005. Details of the works have been mentioned in para 10 of the writ petition. On 16.04.2015, an amount of ₹16,28,096/- has been released to the petitioner but still an amount of ₹76,00,000/- is due to petitioner. He had been approaching the respondents for release of the amount but that has not been till date granted to him. Counsel contends that petitioner had earlier served a notice through counsel dated 01.04.2015 (Annexure P-4) upon the Deputy Commissioner, Bhiwani (Haryana), who is the Commissioner, Municipal Committee, Bhiwani, claiming therein initially an amount of ₹92,00,000/- out of which only an amount of ₹16,28,096/- has been released and an amount of ₹76,00,000/- is still due, which has to be paid to the petitioner.

Counsel contends that the petitioner shall file a detailed representation to respondents 3, 4 and 5 within a period of two weeks from today, which may be directed to be considered and decided within some

specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to Deputy Commissioner, Bhiwani, Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Municipal Committee, Bhiwani, District Bhiwani and Executive Officer, Municipal Committee, Bhiwani, District Bhiwani-respondents 3, 4 and 5 within a period of two weeks from today. If such a representation is made by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided by the said respondents within a period of two months from the date of receipt of such representation. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of two months.
