The grievance of the petitioner is against the order dated 20.04.2015 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench. The Tribunal has declined to issue a direction to the department to supply the documents which the Inquiry Officer has directed to supply to the petitioner to prepare his defence in the pending departmental enquiry.

We are of the considered view that if the departmental authorities do not comply with the order passed by the Inquiry Officer, the petitioner shall be at liberty at the appropriate stage to take the plea of non-observance of

principles of natural justice or he being condemned unheard.

Since the Inquiry Officer has already taken cognizance of his request, no further direction is required to be issued.

Dismissed.
