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Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that the unauthorized construction has already been removed and consequently, submits that the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and may be dismissed as such. Counsel, however, submits that the petitioner is entitled to raise the height of the wall by affixing a grill within the boundaries of the walls of the owner so as to avoid danger to the children going on the roof.

Learned counsel appearing for the State submits that respondents have no objection to affix such a grill within the premises owned by the petitioner.

In view of the stand of the learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition has become infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
