The successors-in-interest of the allottees with possession of land of the big land owner Arjan Singh declared surplus in the year 1960 under the Punjab Security of Land Tenures Act, 1953, are aggrieved by the inaction of the Revenue Officials of District Yamuna Nagar whereby they are refusing to record the relevant entries in favour of the allottees and his successors-in-interest inspite of the fact that the declared surplus area of the big land owner having been upheld upto Hon'ble Supreme Court.

At the time of hearing learned Counsel for the petitioners states that his client would be satisfied if a appropriate direction is given to the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Yamuna Nagar and the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar for deciding their pending representation dated 26.02.2015 (P-9) within some time frame in accordance with law.

Prayer being reasonable is liable to be accepted. Accordingly the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Yamuna Nagar and the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar to take appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation dated 26.02.2015 (**P-9**) within three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is not entitled to the relief a speaking order reflecting the reasons should be passed.
