By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to count his workcharge service from 03.01.1979 to 11.01.1995 and to pay all the arrears of retiral benefits along with interest @ 18% per annum.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had served legal notice dated 27.04.2014 (Annexure P-3), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice Annexure P-3, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
