Petitioners have filed this petition for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant/fix their salary at par with the salary of similarly situated employees.

Admittedly, the petitioners have earlier filed **CWP No.14165 of 2013**, which was disposed of vide order dated 05.07.2013 and a direction, in that case, was issued to the respondents to treat the petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioners and consider their claim in view of the decision of Division Bench of this Court in **Mohinder Singh and others vs State of Haryana and others, CWP No.22516 of 2012** decided on **01.04.2013** within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

As the directions have already been issued by this Court in **CWP No.14165 of 2013** but no action has been taken, a query has been put to learned counsel for the petitioners to show as to how a fresh cause of action has arisen for filing second petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the benefit has not been granted to the present petitioners, whereas, the same has been granted to other persons.

This argument of learned counsel for the petitioners is not going to help the petitioners in any manner when the directions have already been issued. The second petition on the same cause of action is not maintainable. The remedy with the petitioners is to approach the authorities concerned to decide their claim in view of directions issued in the earlier petition if no such action has been taken so far.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take action in view of directions issued in **CWP No.14165 of 2013**.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
