RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India, seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to declare the petitioners as eligible/qualified in the Punjab State Teachers Eligibility Test (PSTET-I) or (PSTET-II) only qua the petitioners, in view of the decision taken by respondent No.3 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion was issued vide order dated 21.05.2015.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Ashwani Kumar, Senior Assistant, office of Director, NCERT, Punjab, submits that since the claim of the petitioners have been found squarely covered by the judgment rendered by Division Bench of this Court dated 31.10.2014 (Annexure P-6), result of the petitioners shall be declared within a period of one week from today. He further submits that present petition may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners fairly states that let the present petition be disposed of in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State.

Disposed of, accordingly.
