The only grievance of the petitioner is that the Divisional Canal Officer, Abohar Canal Division,Abohar is sitting over their application for change of outlet from Muktsar Minor No.11137/L to new outlet No.R.D9187/L for irrigating the land situated in village Thandewala, Tehsil and District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

This Court on the previous date had requested Mr.Yatinder Sharma,Addl.AG Punjab to seek necessary instructions.
