This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to release all the service benefits to the petitioner along with interest @18% per annum for the interim period for which period the petitioner worked/continued in service with the respondents as Professors beyond their retirement age of 60 years and to take action against the respondents in violating their own policy instructions to curb unnecessary litigation.

It has been averred in the petition that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioners have served legal notice dated 18.06.2014 (Annexure P-6), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-6 in terms of judgment titled as **Dr. (Mrs.) Sushma Soni Vs.**

State of Punjab and others passed in CWP No.7688 of 2015, decided on 24.04.2015 (Annexure P-7A), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case the petitioners are found entitled to the benefits sought by them, the same along with all consequential benefits be released within two months thereafter.
