Prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to the respondents to take appropriate action in terms of the directions given by this Court in CWP No. 20909 of 2011 vide order dated 4.9.2013. Further prayer was made to decide the representation dated 7.4.2015 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedy in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies, if any, as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
