AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Petitioners alleged that they have a threat to their life and liberty and therefore, had submitted a representation dated 14.05.2015 (Annexure P-6) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon-respondent No.2. Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon-respondent No.2 to consider and take a decision on their representation dated 14.05.2015 (Annexure P-6).

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, with direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon-respondent No.2 to consider their representation dated 14.05.2015 (Annexure P-6) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, if some substance is found therein.
