2. The petitioners have filed an application under section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 for enhancement. The same was adjourned sine-die as the reference in which the enhancement was granted was pending appeal in this Court. In that appeal, further enhancement was granted. The application under Section 28-A was, therefore, taken up for consideration. Despite the amount having been enhanced by this Court, the Land Acquisition Officer granted enhancement only to the extent ordered by the Reference Court. There is nothing to indicate that the order of this Court has been set-aside. The same appears to have attained finality.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of directing that the petitioners shall be entitled to enhancement as per the order and judgment of this Court dated 01.05.2012 passed in Regular Fist Appeal No. 1714 of 2009 titled as *State of Haryana and another v. Pala Ram and others*.
