Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the retiral benefits of the petitioner.

It is contended that the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in ***Sudarshan Kumar Malik Vs. State of Haryana***, rendered in CWP No.7578 of 2015. It is submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied, in case, the respondents are directed to decide the case of the petitioner in view of Sudarshan Kumar Malik's case (*supra*).

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to examine the case of the petitioner as to whether the same is covered by the ratio of law laid down in Sudarshan Kumar Malik's case (*supra*), within a period of four

months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and if the answer is in affirmative, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioners within a period of two months thereafter.
