AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has highlighted his grievances in a representation dated 14.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the Inspector, Economic Offences Wing, Sector 17, Chandigarh-respondent No.4, which has not been decided till date. He contends that in similar complaints made by respondent No.7, namely, Sh.Ashok Garg son of Sh.Des Raj Garg in Economic Offences Wing, Sector 19, Panchkula, have been gone into and it has been mentioned in the report that it is purely a civil matter, which does not call for any interference on the criminal side by the police authorities. He prays that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to submit the said report before respondent No.4, who may consider the same alongwith representation

dated 14.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) as moved by the petitioner. Counsel submits that the said information shall be supplied by the petitioner by tomorrow prior to taking any further action on Complaint No.PW U0201413522, dated 17.10.2014 of respondent No.7.

In view of the statement made by learned senior counsel for the petitioner, liberty, as prayed for, is granted to the petitioner. In case the requisite information, as has been stated by the counsel in Court, is supplied to respondent No.4 within stipulated time, he shall take that also into consideration prior to proceeding further with the matter.

The petition stands disposed of.
