Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of the respondents, the petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition, under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when the genuine claim of the petitioner was declined by the respondent management vide order dated 12.08.2006 Annexure P9, she filed her statutory appeal dated 27.11.2006 Annexure P10 but the same is also pending decision before respondent no.2. After waiting for a long time, petitioner filed her self contained representation dated 09.04.2014 Annexure P15, for early decision of her appeal Annexure P10, but no action has been taken even thereafter, forcing the petitioner to approach this Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.3 is directed to decide the statutory appeal of the petitioner within reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties at considerable length and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Director, Secondary Education, Haryana – respondent no.3 is directed to look into the matter,

consider the grievance of the petitioner raised in her appeal Annexure P10 and decide the same, if not already decided, at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the above said observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
