Challenge in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to quash the notifications under Section 4 dated 23.08.1960 & Section 6 dated 12.09.1961 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 respectively in view of Section 24(2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in the Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act of 2013 (in short 'the Act).

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to first approach the authorities by submitting notice of demand of his claim under Section 24 (2) of the Act.

3. In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of.

4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies, if any, as may be available to him in accordance with law.
