This order shall dispose of a bunch of 17 petitions bearing CWP Nos.1130, 4412, 4453, 6335, 10429, 10445, 10453, 10428, 10454, 10446, 10419, 10427, 10430, 23313 & 13739 of 2014

and 438 & 2819 of 2015, as learned counsel for the parties are agreed that common issues are involved therein in all the petitions.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the land of the petitioners had been acquired for the benefit of private builders so that they can sell the flats at the higher rates. It was also stated that inadvertently, the beneficiary-private builders have not been impleaded as party respondent(s) and prayer has been made that the petitioners be permitted to withdraw the present petitions with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh petition(s) on the same cause of action by impleading appropriate and necessary parties.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. However, petitioner(s) would be at liberty to file the writ petition (s) within three months from today.

4. In case, such writ petitions are filed by the petitioners, the Registry shall append the record of the respective writ petition along with the same.
