AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that an amount of ₹15,42,389.80 is due from the Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Limited. Petitioner has been approaching the respondents since the year 2009 onwards but without any response, as till date the amount due, has not been released to the petitioner. Reference has been made by the counsel for the petitioner to the representation dated 08.11.2014 (Annexure P-3) addressed to the respondent-authorities but that also has not yielded any result.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents 1 and 2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 08.11.2014 (Annexure P-3) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present

writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Managing Director, The Punjab State Co-operative Supply & Marketing Federation Limited, Chandigarh and District Manager, The Punjab State Co-operative Supply & Marketing Federation Limited, Gurdaspur-respondents 1 and 2 respectively, to consider and decide the representation dated 08.11.2014 (Annexure P-3), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to it, in accordance with law, within a further period of four weeks. In case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
