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MAHESH GROVER, J.

The limited grievance of the petitioner is that some moveable pieces of furniture; generator, ACs, fans, almirah, racks, cabins and related records of the company are lying in the premises which is now the subject-matter of proceedings under the SARFAESI Act. The respondent-bank has taken possession of the property. The petitioner was a tenant in such premises and thus claims that the respondent-bank would have no claim to the afore-noticed material belonging to him and thus prays for its release.

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 states that he has instructions to say that they would have no objection to such material being taken back by the petitioner.

In view of the afore-stated stand of the parties, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction that the petitioner shall approach the respondents No.1 and 2 on 15.6.2015 and in the presence of the bank officials he shall be permitted to remove the above mentioned records etc. against receipt. Ordered accordingly.
