By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek quashing of the order dated 29.04.2004 (Annexure P-1), whereby the petitioners father has been dismissed from service on account of his conviction.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of their grievances, the petitioners have moved representation (Annexure P-7), however, the same has not been decided so far. He further asserts that the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down by this Court in case **Balwant Kaur** Vs. **State of Punjab and another**, 1987(5) SLR 264 and **Shrimati Kanta Devi** Vs. **State of Punjab and others**, 1988(1) SLR 642.

In the circumstances, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.3, to examine as to whether the case of the petitioners is covered by the above case law and to decide the representation (Annexure P-7), in terms of the above case law, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
