The order of recovery dated 10.04.2015 (Annexure P-3) under challenge in the present petition has been passed by the Chairman of the Punjab Mandi Board.

It is not in dispute that against the impugned order, the petitioner has a remedy of filing a revision petition before the State Government under Section 42 of the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets Act, 1961 (for short "the Act").

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to avail the remedy of filing a revision petition before the State Government under the Act.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

If any revision petition, within seven days from today, is filed by the petitioner, the State Government would decide the same by passing a speaking order after hearing the petitioner preferably within two months from the date of receipt of the revision petition. It is further directed that till the filing of the revision petition, no recovery shall be effected from the petitioner.
