This common order shall dispose of the
aforementioned five writ petitions since similar facts and
identical issues are involved in the same.

It has not been disputed that after filing of the
instant writ petitions the State of Haryana has constituted
Educational Tribunal for redressal of grievances of the
employees of aided/unaided Educational Institutions.

Learned counsel for the petitioners have relied on
certain decisions of this Court where similar claims were
decided but they are prior in time to the constitution of the
Educational Tribunal. Once the Educational Tribunal has been
constituted, it may not be proper to proceed with these writ
petitions in view of the availability of the said Forum for
redressal of the grievances of the petitioners.

In view thereof, these petitions are disposed of
relegating the petitioners to avail their alternate remedy before
the Education Tribunal. As the matter has been pending for quite
some time, it is expected that the Tribunal would make an
endeavour to decide the cases at an early date.
