AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the highly exorbitant electricity bills are being served upon the petitioner who is having a small house. He states that the petitioner would file a detailed representation to the Sub-Divisional Officer, Ajnala, within a period of two weeks from today highlighting therein the difficulties which the petitioner is facing because of the excessive charging of the electricity actually consumed by the petitioner and for the rectification of the same which may be directed to be considered and decision taken thereon, in accordance with law, within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to the Sub-Divisional Officer, Ajnala within a period of 15 days from today. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decision taken thereon by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Ajnala within a period of eight weeks from the date of submission of such representation. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
