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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record letter dated 26.10.2015 issued from the office of DIGP, GC, CRPF, Sarikhas, Jalandhar to the petitioner, in which it has been stated that as per order passed in CWP No.11487 of 2014 , a Medical Board was constituted at PGI, Chandigarh for conducting the medical examination of the petitioner. As per the report of the Board of Doctors of PGI, Chandigarh, the petitioner was declared fit for appointment. As per the said communication, the petitioner is required to report along with certificates and medical certificates by 20.11.2015. It states that the other terms and conditions as mentioned in the office letter dated 22.2.2014 will remain unchanged.

In view of the above, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed and this petition has become infructuous.

As the letter itself states that the other terms and conditions as mentioned in the letter dated 22.2.2014 will remain unchanged. The necessary consequence would be that the appointment of the petitioner would relate back to the date when the batch in which the petitioner was selected, had joined.

It is made clear that the said benefit would only be qua the seniority of the petitioner but he would not be entitled to salary etc. for the period before his joining.
