AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner has claimed regularization in terms of the Government policy dated 18.06.2014 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel states that in this regard the petitioner has also moved a legal notice dated 26.02.2015 (Annexure P-13) and that he would be satisfied at this stage if in the first instance a direction is issued to the respondent No.4 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, the respondent No.4 is directed to decide the said notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy

of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
