The petitioners seek quashing of order dated 24.07.2012 (Annexure P-9), passed by respondent No.2, whereby, their claim for counting service from the date of their joining has been rejected.

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners states that he does not press the present petition on its merits. At this stage, he will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to treat the present petition as a representation and decided the same in terms of LPA No.1683 of 2013, decided on 29.10.2013, titled as State of Punjab and others Vs. Satish Rani Sood, who is a similarly situated employee.

In view of the statement made, the present petition is

disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same by passing a speaking and reasoned order in terms of LPA No.1683 of 2013. The needful be done within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and in case, the petitioner is found entitled, the necessary benefits be paid to the petitioner within a period of one month thereafter.
