After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that they would in the first instance make a representation to the Municipal Corporation – respondent in terms of the judgment rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court as also the Act ***The Street Vendors (Protection of livelihood and regulation of street vending) Act, 2014.***

If the representation is made by the petitioners within a period of one week from today, the same shall be considered appropriately by the Municipal Corporation and disposed of in accordance with law within a period of 15 days thereafter.

Till the time the representation is decided, the eviction of the petitioners shall be stayed.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
