AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks a mandamus to direct the respondent-authorities to provide him employment as per the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme dated 18.11.1993 (Annexure P-1).

The above stated relief has been sought on the basis of the judgment of this Court rendered in CWP No.787 of 2008 (Dharam Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and others) decided on 26.11.2009 (Annexure P-5) which has been upheld by the Division Bench in LPA No.1412 of 2009 (State of Punjab and others Versus Dharam Singh and others) decided on 21.01.2010 (Annexure P-6) as well as the Hon'ble Supreme Court while dismissing the Special Leave Petition on 28.02.2011 (Annexure P-7). Petitioner has moved a representation to the respondents dated 25.04.2015 (Annexure P-9) staking his claim but no decision has been taken thereon.

In these circumstances, when the matter stands settled up to the highest Court, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner as submitted

by him through his representation dated 25.04.2015 (Annexure P-9) for providing him employment under the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme dated 18.11.1993, in the light of the above cited decisions. However, if the respondents find that the claim of the petitioner is distinguishable, they shall dispose of it by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
