AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of promotion to the post of Medical Laboratory Technician Grade-I, w.e.f. 23.02.2006, the date, his juniors were promoted and is also entitled to other consequential benefits. Claiming the said benefit, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 10.11.2014 (Annexure P-9) to the Director, Research and Medical Education, Punjab, but no response thereto has been received. Counsel contends that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to the Director, Research and Medical Education, Punjab-respondent No.2 within a period of four weeks from today and direction may be issued to the said respondent to decide the same within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed without going into

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merit of the case and commenting thereon, with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to the Director, Research and Medical Education, Punjab-respondent No.2 within a period of four weeks from today. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided by the Director, Research and Medical Education, Punjab-respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of submission of such representation.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of six weeks. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
