Petitioner has approached this Court primarily putting forward a grievance that illegal encroachments have been made by some of the persons, which have been pointed out to the respondents and on the directions issued by this Court, the Deputy Commissioner had a meeting with the concerned officials and proceedings for removal of encroachments have been initiated. Counsel contends that a direction may be issued to expedite the said process.

Without even knowing the actual position and ground realities with regard to the pendency of the proceedings and the stage thereof, this Court cannot give a general direction to expedite the same. The present writ petition, therefore, cannot be entertained at this stage.

The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
