The petitioner has though challenged the order dated 14.4.2015 passed by the Registrar of the University expelling his son but at the same time liberty was given to the petitioner to challenge the order of expulsion by way of an appeal before the Vice Chancellor. The petitioner has done the same as the appeal has been filed but so far no decision has been taken by respondent No.2.

At this stage, the innocuous prayer made by the petitioner is only for the disposal of his appeal within a prescribed time.

Since, the prayer made by the petitioner is such which do not require the presence of the respondents, therefore, without issuing notice to them, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
