Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for grant of regular promotion of Joint Director (Feed and Fodder), Punjab, along with all consequential benefits.

It is contended that the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in ***Madan Lal and others Vs. State of Punjab***, rendered in CWP No.9325 of 2011.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to examine the case of the petitioner as to whether the same is covered by the ratio of law laid down in Madan Lal's case (supra), within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and if the answer is in affirmative, the consequential benefits be released to

the petitioners within a period of two months thereafter.
