Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.3-Divisional Canal Officer, Tohana to execute the order dated 26.12.2014 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Sub Divisional Canal Officer, Tohana vide which watercourse demolished by respondent No.6 has been ordered to be restored.

Learned counsel for respondent No.6 points out that the order dated 26.12.2014 (Annexure P-3) has been set aside by the

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Superintending Canal Officer and matter has been remanded to the Divisional Canal Officer for afresh decision.

In view of above, instant petition does not survive.

The petitioner will be at liberty to appear before the Divisional Canal Officer and contest the proceedings.
