MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner impugns his transfer by alleging mala fides. However, the petition does not disclose the names of the persons against whom mala fides are alleged. The solitary plea raised for impugning the transfer is that the petitioner remained at Amristar, merely for 4 years while respondent no.4 has remained there for 10 years. These are matters of administrative convenience with which this Court in the exercise of its jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India will not interfere.

Hence, dismissed.
