The petitioner impugns the order of her transfer dated 13.1.2015
(Annexure P-1).

The facts would indicate that petitioner has remained posted at
Sonapat for an inordinate long time.

Be that as it may, it is not in dispute that husband of the petitioner is
posted at Panipat and the petitioner is now posted in some area near Karnal which

is not far away from her husband's place of posting. In any case, these are administrative matters in which this court should not ordinarily interfere in the exercise of its jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

The petition is therefore, disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents for the redressal of her grievance.
