The petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to the respondents to release of the family pension, gratuity and leave encashment, etc., along with interest.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-8, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, to consider and decide the legal notice, Annexure P-8, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
