1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The claim is for grant of ACP after completion of 24 years of service. In this connection the petitioner has also got issued a legal notice dated 15.03.2015(Annexure P-1) on the respondents but till date no action has been taken thereon. Learned counsel states that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice within any reasonable time by passing a speaking order thereon.

I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice(Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order thereon.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
