AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court, alleging maltreatment and even mishandling at the hands of their son-respondent No.6. Counsel contends that because of the beatings given to petitioner No.1 (father of respondent No.6), he received injuries, because of which he was got admitted to Civil Hospital, Dhuri, from where he was referred to Rajindra Hospital, Patiala and finally to Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh, where he remained admitted w.e.f. 21.04.2015 to 24.04.2015.

Counsel contends that the petitioners will make a detailed representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur and the Station House Officer, Police Station Dhuri, District Sangrur, respondent Nos.3 and 4 respectively, who may be directed to consider the

same and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

In view of the assertion made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur and the Station House Officer, Police Station Dhuri, District Sangrur, respondent Nos.3 and 4 respectively, that in case the petitioners submit a representation to them, the same shall be looked into and if the averments made therein are found to be correct, appropriate steps in accordance with law be initiated forthwith.
