1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The claim of the petitioner is that he was declared temporarily unfit and now he is fit and is praying for a review medical examination. Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has moved a representation dated 05.05.2015(Annexure P-7) which has not been decided as yet. Learned counsel states that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation within any reasonable time by passing a speaking order thereon.

I find this to be a fair request.

Resultantly this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a

certified copy of this order in accordance with law by passing a speaking order thereon.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
