ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, although, during the pendency of the writ petition, the respondents have granted the benefit under the Assured Career Progression Scheme to the petitioners from the date of their joining regular service, on completion of 4/9/14 years of service and their pay stands revised, however, the benefits in terms of the said decision are yet to be received. He further submits that, substantially, the petition has become infructuous but the respondents be directed to release the necessary benefits, in terms of the decisions dated 28.04.2014 (Annexures R-1 and R-2), within a specified time.

Learned State counsel submits that once, in principle, the benefit under the Scheme has been granted to the

petitioners, the matter is being processed and the petitioners will receive the benefits in due course. He submits, that at best, the needful would be done within 3 months from today.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that nothing substantive survives in the petition and the same be dismissed as having become infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
