The claim of the petitioner for 2nd and 3rd ACP has not been decided. In this connection, the petitioner has got issued a legal notice dated 2.3.2015 (Annexure P-4) and that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice within any reasonable time by passing a speaking order.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order within two months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to any amount/s, the same be released to him within two months thereafter, failing which he would be entitled to claim the same with interest @ 8% pa from the date/s the amount/s fell due till the date of payment.
