The dispute in the present writ petition is relating to land bearing Khasra Nos. 3//11(8-0), 20(8-0), 21(8-0), 6//1/1(1-0), 10/1/2(0-15), 7//5/1/3(1-4) and 6/1/1(0-15) situated in the revenue estate of village Jhanjhanwas, Tehsil and District, Rewari.

2. As per reply dated 24.3.2015 filed by Satyabir Singh, Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estate, Gurgaon on behalf of respondent No. 5, land measuring 7 marla of the petitioners has already been released. Para

3 of the reply reads as under:-

“That the constructed area petitioner in the land bearing khasra no. 3//11(8-0), 20(8-0), 21(8-0), 6//1/1(1-0), 10/1/2(0-15), 7//5/1/3(1-4), 6/1/1(0-15) to the extent of their share 7/554 i.e. (0-7 marla) has already released by the competent authority vide instruction issued in letter no. 12/13/2013-3TCP dated 7.11.2014.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the above, the writ petition may be disposed of as infructuous.
