Writ in the nature of mandamus is prayed for, so as to direct the respondents to afford the revised pay scale of ₹ 10300-34800 and pay grade ₹ 4400/- to the petitioners on completion of 4 years service as Teachers under the Assured Career Progression Scheme, in terms of the Punjab Government instructions dated 25.09.1998 (Annexure P1), notification dated 29.07.2009 (Annexure P2) and instructions dated 20.12.2011 (Annexure P4), along with all consequential benefits, such as arrears of salary, revised scale of pay etc. It is maintained that prior to the institution of this petition, petitioners had even represented to respondents No.3 & 4, vide representations dated 14.05.2014 & 11.03.2015 (Annexure P5 Colly.) in this regard. But to no avail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondents No.3 & 4, to consider and decide the representations (Annexure P5 Colly.), submitted by the petitioners, within a specified time.

That being so, and without expressing any opinion on merits, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3 and 4, to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners, as set out in their representations dated 14.05.2014 & 11.03.2015 (Annexure P5 Colly.), strictly in accordance with law, within a period of three months, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed assigning reasons, in support of the decision arrived at.
