The claim in this writ petition is for certain dues. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is to retire on 30.6.2015 and for these dues, he has got issued a legal notice dated 19.3.2014 (Annexure P-6) and that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice within any reasonable time by passing a speaking order.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order within two months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to any amount/s, the same be released to him within four months,

failing which he would be entitled to claim the same with interest @ 8% pa
from the date/s the amount/s fell due till the date of payment.
