HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner applied in response to advertisement for recruitment of Constables GD & Rifleman vacancies in BSF, CISF, CRPF, ITPB, SSB & ASSAM Rifle Man. The petitioners applied in the category of border area and reserved class. It is stated that after clearing Physical Efficiency Test, they appeared for the written examination and were called for medical test.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioners were also declared medically fit. Initially, the department released the first list recruiting 37000 candidates wherein the name of the petitioners did not figure. Thereafter, in the month of July, 2015, respondent-department issued a revised list, wherein, again names of the petitioners did not figure.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the candidates lower in merit than the petitioners have been selected, ignoring the petitioners.

The petitioners have been repeatedly representing the respondents to know as to why they despite being medically fit and higher in merit have not been selected. However, no response has been received.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the claim as contained in their legal notices (Annexure P-8A to P-8-D).

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the claim of the petitioners as contained in in their legal notices (Annexure P-8A-P-8-D), expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
