AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

The claim in the present petition is for the grant of fixed medical allowance.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has got issued Legal Notice dated 05.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) and that she would be satisfied at this stage if in the first instance a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request.

Without commenting to the merits of the case, the

respondent No.2 is directed to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
