They jointly pray for relegating the petitioner to her alternative remedy before the Education Tribunal.

In view of the above common stand taken by learned counsel for the parties, petitioner is relegated to her alternative remedy before the Education Tribunal. However, since the petitioner

had been pursuing her case before this Court, pendency of her petition before this Court will be taken into consideration by the Education Tribunal and the limitation will not come in the way of the petitioner, while pursuing her remedy before the Tribunal.
