The relief sought in the present writ petition is for issuance of the NOC, as per the policy for opening of a Self-Financed Degree College. It is further prayed that provisional permission/affiliation be granted to admit students for the said degree college, for the session 2015-16.

In the reply, the State took the defence that as per the inspection conducted on 23.04.2015, the building was incomplete and also appended photographs.

This Court, vide order dated 03.08.2015, directed the respondents to inspect the institution to find out as to whether it satisfies all the norms for grant of NOC.

In pursuance of the said order, the inspection report has been furnished. A perusal of the inspection report goes on to show that though the report is that the building and ground-floor construction has been completed but a closure perusal goes on to show that there is neither any boundary wall of the playground, the toilets for girls is without tiles, the lighting is with a generator and the staff is yet to be appointed, as advertisement is to be given.

Accordingly, keeping in view the inspection report, let a fresh decision be taken by the appropriate authority, for the issuance of the letter of NOC, within a period of four weeks, from the receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
